2017-2018 SEASON

Monthly Lesson Fees

Beginners, 1 hour weekly / 6 lessons per session [6 hours] - \$ 115

Team, 1 hour weekly / 4 lessons per month [4 hours] - \$ 77

Team, 1.5 hours weekly / 4 lessons per month [6 hours] - \$ 98

Team, 2 hours weekly / 4 lessons per month [8 hours] - \$ 119

Individual Member monthly fee [regardless of hours of instruction] \$ 47

Coach's private lesson fee paid directly to Coach, and amount varies by coach.

Individual members are those taking only private lessons, no team.

Fees are non-refundable. Fees are due the first lesson of each month or session. After the first lesson, a \$15 late fee is incurred per student. Monthly fees cannot be prorated due to student absences. Coach will make up missed material in future lessons. Months with fewer than 4 scheduled lessons due to holidays or extreme weather will have additional lessons scheduled by the coach to complete the 4 per month. Club dues are assessed PER FAMILY, so additional twirlers in same family may deduct \$35 from their monthly lesson fees on additional twirlers.

Costs through the season

USTA annual membership dues Non-refundable; annual, required at first registration in September, or whenever member first joins: \$18 First Year Member/ \$35 renewal current member

Regulation Baton of correct size and style \$29-38

Registration Fee 2nd year+ members, Non-refundable; annual. \$40 per student

Includes seasonal liability insurance and corps logo T-shirt

Corps Fee 2nd year+ members, Non-refundable; annual. \$75 per family

Used for administrative costs, i.e., storage, facilities, notices, supplies, fundraising, corps costuming, props, etc. OR your family may seek an outside donation of \$75 or greater to be collected by September 30 (may come from a business sponsorship, a matching donation program through some employers, etc.)

Corps logo clothing required –2nd year+ members, jacket with logo, logo tshirt \$0 - 120

Group costumes as specified by coach, ordered in November, tights \$0 - 100

In-Step Shoes color as specified by coach, properly fitting \$0 - 43

Meet entry fees varies by number of events and divisions entered at contests \$0 - 200

All Corps families are required to participate in the annual primary corps fundraiser, i.e., *currently Alaska Sled Dog Racing Association [ASDRA] minimum 2 sessions staffing, OR such other primary fundraiser as named by Club.*

MEMBER BEHAVIOR: I, as a member, will behave in a reasonable manner to other members, my teammates, and my coach. I will:

- Treat others with respect and tolerance
- Respect the decisions of my coach
- Discuss problems in a civil manner, instead of confrontation or avoidance
- Display good sportsmanship at all times and be a team player

LESSONS AND PRACTICE: I realize that there is a limited amount of time for my coach to instruct my team. In order to maximize available learning time, I will:

- Show up on time for practice
- Contact the coach beforehand if I will be late or absent for class
- Arrive with my own equipment, which will be in good condition
- Avoid unnecessary interruptions
- Dress in appropriate athletic wear, including shoes
- Tie back long hair or otherwise keep hair off my face
- Bring my ABC skills book and a water bottle to all classes
- Between classes, practice as suggested by my coach

PERFORMANCES AND COMPETITION: I will:

- Arrive at the time stated for twirlers
- Wear the appropriate costume, hair, and makeup as explained by my coach
- Warm up sufficiently to avoid injuries
- Wear my corps logo clothing when not performing
- Watch and cheer for other corps members and not be rude to competitors
